Harry Levi Langham

The 1910 census says he was a wagon driver for a coal merchant in Toledo, OH. He moved his family from the Toledo area to Bunkerhill in 1920 or 1921, after his daughter Marian was killed by a auto driven by a doctor that was drunk.

In Bunker Hill, MI, he and his family lived on Williamston Rd. He was a teamster. He also did roadwork and helped build roads in Flint, MI. He farmed in Bunkerhil, and took his produce to the Detroit Farmers Market every week.

He built a smaller home after the children were all gone, but that house burnt and is no longer there. He played the Banjo. He loved to hunt, and had coon dogs.
